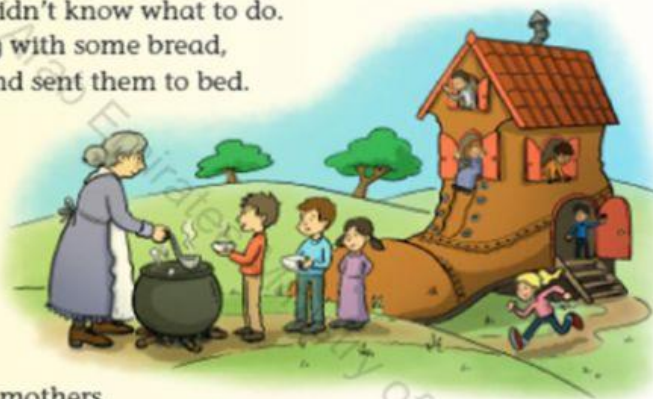
The old woman who lived in a shoe
