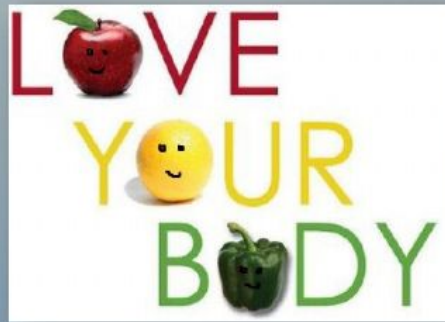

How to wash my hands

Using the World Health Organization method.



1 Wet your hands



2 Use enough soap to cover your both hands entirely



3 Rub your hands palm to palm



4 Put one palm on top of your other hand, interlace your fingers and rub. Repeat with the other hand.



5 Put your palms together and interlace your fingers and rub.



6 Rub the back of your fingers together with your hands in fists



7 Make a fist around your thumb and rub rotationally. Repeat on the other hand.



8 Clasp your fingers together and rub them in a circle in the palm of your other hand. Make sure to do this on both hands.



9 Rinse your hands with water.



10 Your hands are now clean and safe!



11 If you are at home, dry your hands with a CLEAN towel. If you are in public, remember to open the tap with a single use towel, throw it away, dry your hands with a new single use towel, close the tap with it, and throw it away too.
