Story #1: Tim Horton



When he was 19 years old, he joined the Toronto Maple Leafs professional hockey team. He played with them for 17 years. In 1963, Tim decided to open a doughnut shop with his friend in Hamilton, Ontario. Soon many cities in Canada had "Tim Hortons" doughnut shops. Sadly, Tim Horton died in a car accident in 1974. Today "Tim Hortons" has more than 3000 doughnut shops across Canada.

She would travel around British Columbia in a canoe to get close to nature. Emily Carr died in Victoria, British Columbia in 1945
