### Explanation

In present simple, we add "s" in the verb in the Third Person Singular.

We add "s" in the most of the verbs.

I play – He **plays**

I sleep – She **sleeps**

But we also have irregular verbs, in this case the whole word is changed.

Have is irregular:

Have – **Has**

Haven't – **Hasn't**
