

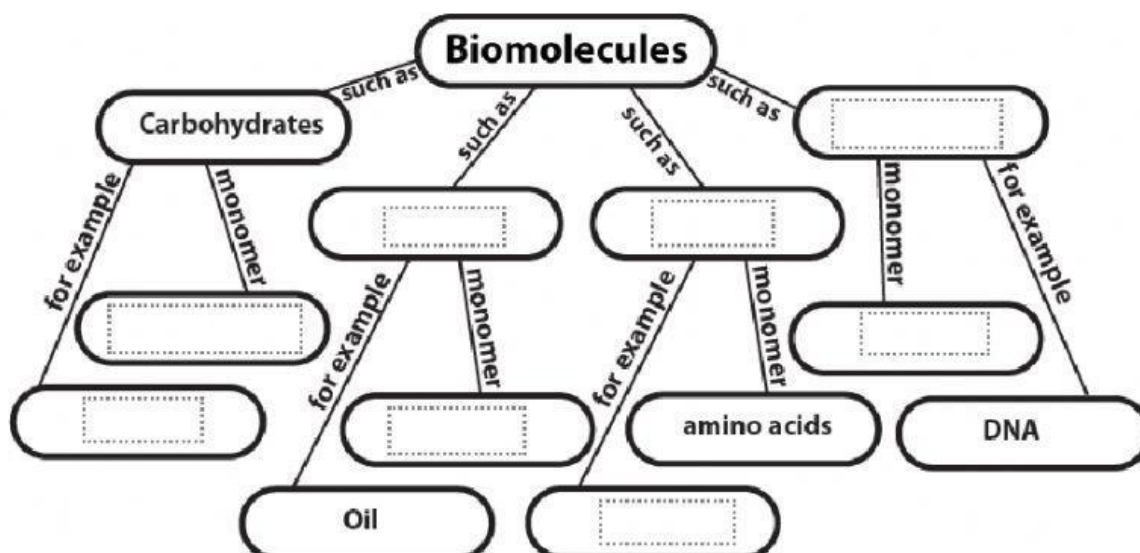
Chapter 1.4 Building Blocks of Life

The building blocks of Life are called **Biomolecules / Macromolecules**. These include:

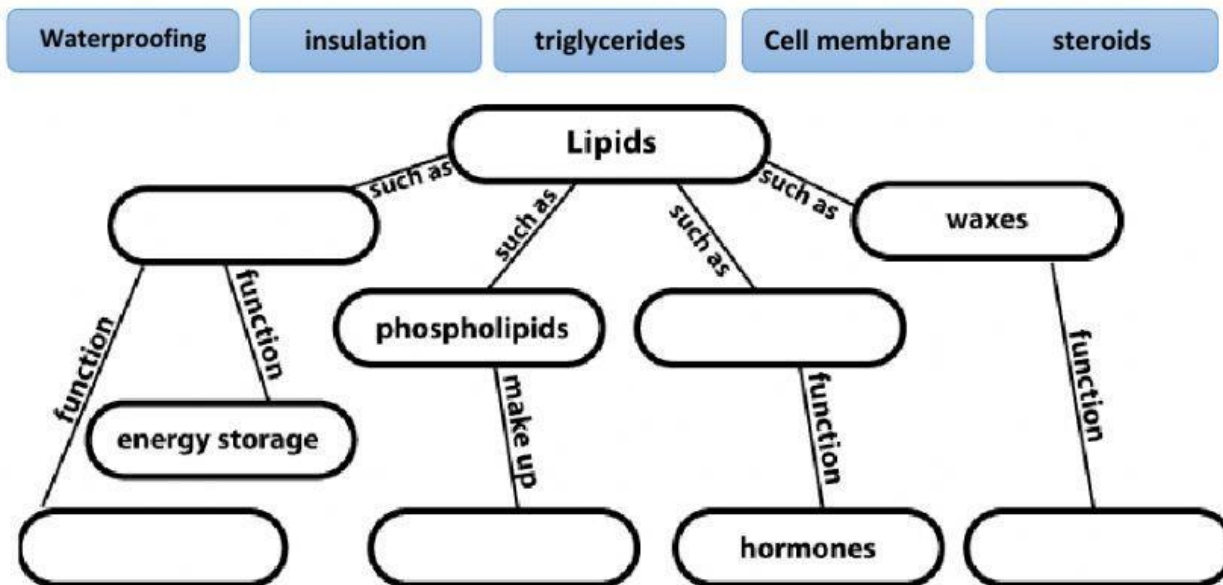
1. Carbohydrates

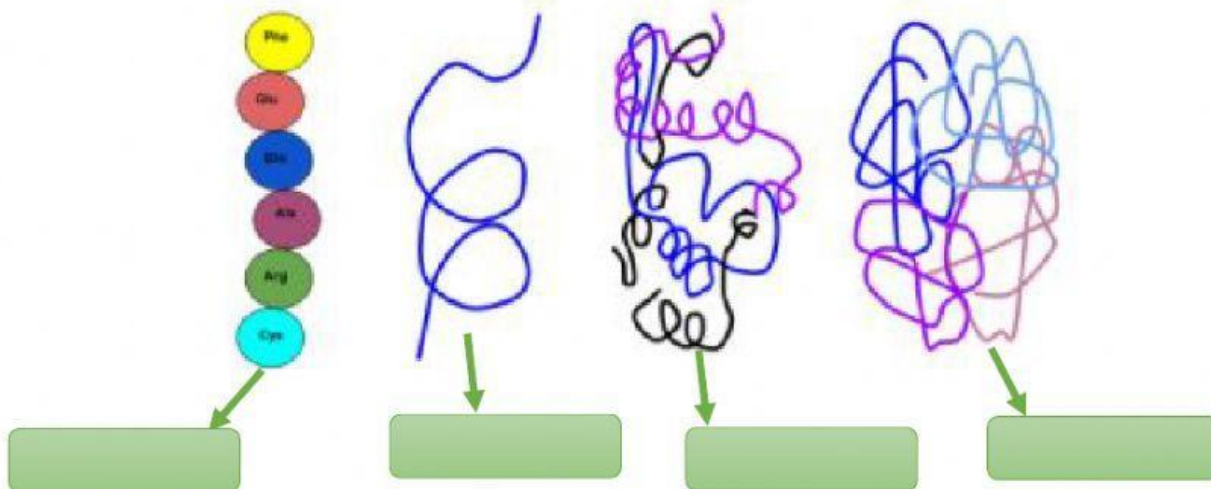
