### CONNECTIVES: AND- SO- BUT

To know the correct connective that can join two sentences, you need to understand the meaning of the sentences, and the relationship between the two sentences.

**Example:** - I studied the words, **but** I didn't pass the test. ("but" links a positive and a negative idea)

- I finished my lunch, **and** we went outside to play. ("and" links two ideas that are related)
- It was raining a lot, **so** I took my umbrella. ("so" gives a result)
