Birds are covered with feathers. Feathers help to keep birds warm. Some feathers also help birds to fly. Birds have wings to help them fly. Like mammals, birds have lungs to help them breathe air. Many birds also care for their young for a while after they are born. Unlike most young mammals, young birds hatch from eggs.
