Science

Grasses

Grass that grows on the prairies provides food for wild animals. This is called forage grass. Hay is made from grass. Cows and horses eat hay. These kinds of grasses are a very important food source.

Other grasses are called cereal grasses. These are the kinds of grass plants that people eat. Wheat is a cereal grass.

Trees

A tree is a plant that has a special kind of stem called a trunk. A tree's trunk makes it very strong.

Barks helps to protect the tree. Tree trunks are covered with bark. Trees can grow to be very tall but can also be very small.

Shrubs or bushes are similar to trees. But they have more than one stem. Bushes are not as strong or as tall as trees.

Seeds

God designed plants to make seeds so that new plants can grow. Each seed grows into the type of plant it came from.
