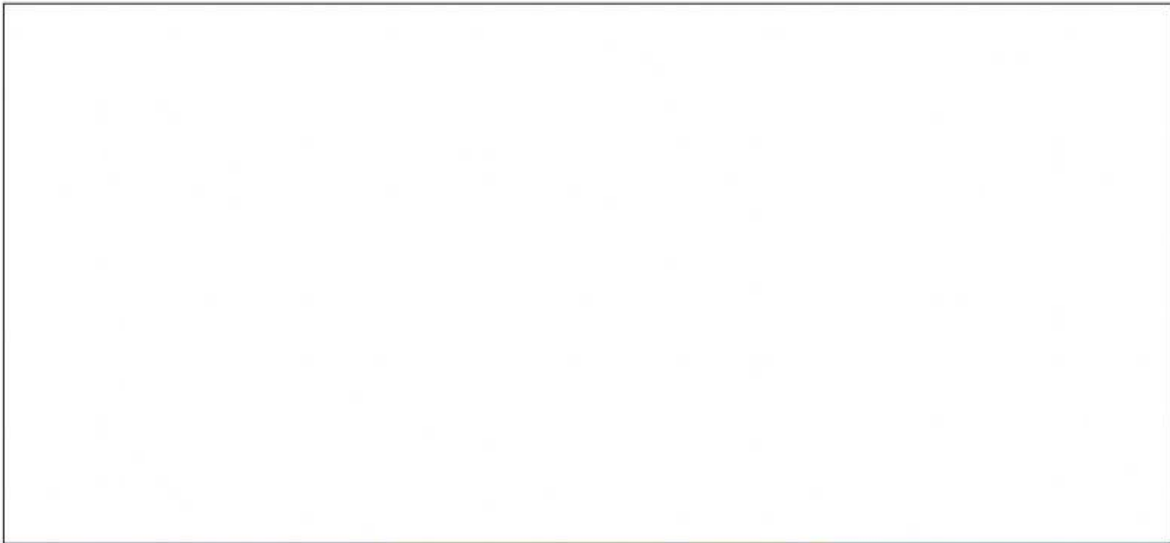

Positive	Negative	Question
He She It + starts « 1st form of verb + '-s, -es, -ies' »	He She It + does not doesn't + start « 1st form of verb »	Does + He She It + start « 1st form of verb »
I You We You They + start « 1st form of verb »	I You We You You They + do not don't + start « 1st form of verb »	Do + I You We You They + start « 1st form of verb »
Example: She starts new diet. Example: You start new diet.	Example: She does not (doesn't) start new diet. Example: You do not (don't) start new diet.	Ex: She starts new diet. Ex: You start new diet. Does she start new diet? Do you start new diet?

She	+	is not	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
It		isn't			« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
You					
We	+	are not	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
You		aren't			« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
They					

Example: He **is not (isn't) working** in the garden.

Question

Am	+	I	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
Is	+	He She It	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »
Are	+	You We You They	+	working	« 1st form of verb + '-ing' »

Example: **He is working** in the garden.

Example: **Is he working** in the garden?

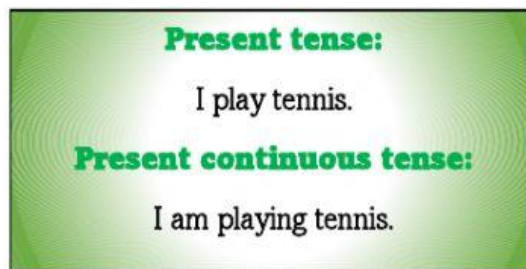
