## Reading Comprehension

### Story Elements: Character(s), Setting and Plot (Problem and Solution)

A story has different parts or elements.

Story used: The Lion and the Mouse

**1. Character(s)** are the people, animals or other creatures in the story.  
Character(s) are - “WHO” in the story.

E.g. The lion, mouse and the hunter

**2. Setting** – is the place and time, when and where the story happens.  
Setting is the WHERE and WHEN in the story.

E.g. place- jungle      time- afternoon

**3. Plot** – is the actions or events that takes place in the story.

It has the beginning, the middle and ending events.

The plot also has a problem and a solution.

**Plot** is the WHAT and WHY in the story.

**Problem** tells what happens or tells the difficulty a character is facing.

**Solution** tells what the character does to solve the problem(s).

The solution is also called the resolution.

**REMEMBER:** Whenever you are reading:

**character(s)** are the WHO

**setting** – is the WHEN and WHERE

**Plot** is the WHAT and WHY
