- one of the rivers that gave rise to the ancient Mesopotamian civilization, along with the Tigris
- a river that flows from the Tibetan mountains to Myanmar, Laos, Cambodia, Thailand, and Vietnam
- a river considered sacred by the Hindus
- an underground river that flows 8 km underground, through a cave, and empties into the West Philippine Sea
- the third longest river in the world
- a river in South America that is considered one of the two longest rivers in the world, along with the Nile
- a river in South America whose colorful appearance at certain months is in part due to Macarenia clavigera
- a river that overflowed its banks annually, leaving a fertile plain that enabled the rise of the Egyptian civilization
- a river that, along with its tributaries, forms the largest network of navigable waterways in Africa
- a river sometimes referred to as "the Everest of rivers"
