Imperative and Exclamatory Sentences

Remember: All sentences begin with a capital letter and ends with a punctuation mark.

A. Imperative Sentence

An imperative sentence gives a command, provides instruction or offers an advice. Imperative sentences end with a period (•).

For example:

- 1. Brush your teeth twice a day.
- 2. Clean your room.

B. Exclamatory Sentence

An exclamatory sentence shows strong feeling or surprise.

Exclamatory Sentences end with an exclamation mark (!).

For example:

- 1. Hooray! We won the game!
- 2. Wow, he performed very well!
