

ANSWERING QUESTIONS!

When we answer a question, we often use 'yes' or 'no'. If we answer questions about things we do or like doing, we also need to use 'do' or 'does'. Here is how we do it. Look at the pronoun to know if we use 'do' or 'does'.

I = do.

We = do.

He = does.

It = does.

You = do.

They = do.

She = does.



Do they like to dance?

Yes, they



Does he like to eat?

Yes, he



Do they like to sleep quietly?

Yes, they



Does she like to shout loudly?

Yes, she
