



Robert Louis Stevenson



Robert Louis Stevenson was the author of *Treasure Island*. He wrote the novel in 1881 – 1882. Readers loved this story of the discovery of buried treasure. His most famous character, Long John Silver, first appeared in *Treasure Island*, and the pirate captain is still one of the most iconic figures in British literature today.

Stevenson also wrote *Strange Case of Doctor Jekyll and Mister Hyde*. In this horror story, Dr. Jekyll changed into a terrible monster after he did a disastrous experiment with some chemicals. Stevenson got the inspiration for his classic novel from a dream.

Robert Louis Stevenson was born in Scotland in 1850. He studied engineering at the University of Edinburgh. Then he worked as a writer all his life. He travelled all over the world. Eventually, the writer decided to live in Samoa in the Pacific Ocean. Unfortunately, he never had good health and he died there in 1894 at the age of 44.
