Urban development is having a direct impact on the weather in many cities worldwide. It has been noticed that the difference (28) temperature is usually greater at night and the phenomenon occurs in both winter and summer. Experts agree that this is due to urban development, when open green spaces are replaced with asphalt roads and tall brick or concrete buildings. These materials retain heat generated by the Sun and release it through the night. In Atlanta, in the US, this has even led to thunderstorms(29) occur in the morning rather than, as is more common, in the afternoon.

Large cities around the world are adopting strategies to combat this issue (30) it is not uncommon to find plants growing on top of roofs or down the walls of large buildings. In Singapore, the government has (31) to transform it into a "city within a garden" and, in 2006, they held an international competition calling for entries to develop a master plan to help bring this about.
