

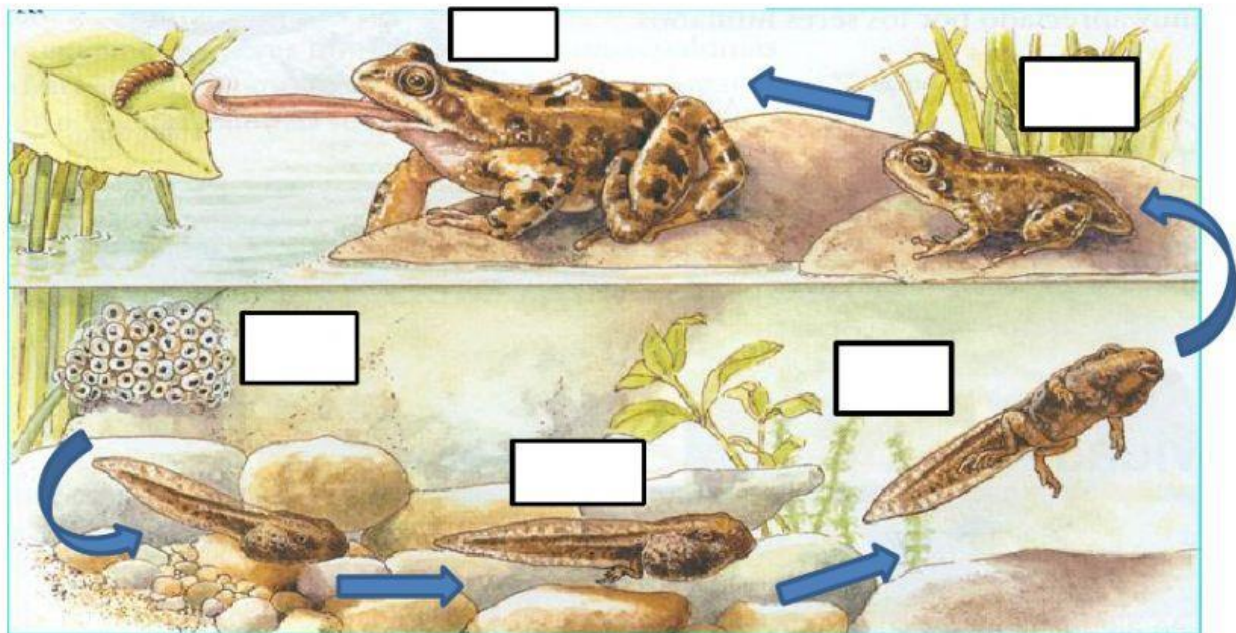

2. Organize the phases of the metamorphosis.



It becomes an adult frog. Now it has lungs and can live outside the water.

Over time, the tadpole develops legs.

An adult frog lays many eggs in the water.

A tadpole is born from each egg. They breathe through gills. They live in the water.

It becomes a froglet. Its tail gets smaller and its legs grow stronger.
