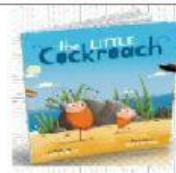


Non-Fiction Text Features

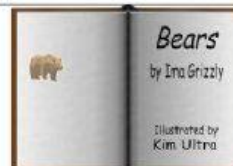
Book Cover



- ✓ The book cover has:
- ✓ the title or name of the book.
- ✓ the author's name.
- ✓ the illustrator's name.




Title Page

- ✓ The page at the beginning of a book giving its title, the names of the author and illustrator is called the Title Page.



<p>Table of Contents</p>	<p>✓ Lists the chapters of a book along with their page numbers.</p>	
<p>Heading</p>	<p>✓ The heading divides the text into sections and explains what the sections will be about. ✓ It is often in bold or capital letters.</p>	

<p>Pictures</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Pictures also help the reader understand an idea from the text that was unclear. ✓ Photos and illustrations give information in a visual way. 	
<p>Bold</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Bold prints are words that are bolder and much darker than the other printed words. ✓ 	<p>A Male killer whale is called a bull.</p> <p>Female killer whale is referred to as a cow and a baby killer whale is called a calf.</p>
