







Non-Fiction Text Features		
Book Cover	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ The book cover has:</li> <li>✓ the title or name of the book.</li> <li>✓ the author's name.</li> <li>✓ the illustrator's name.</li> </ul>	
Title Page	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ The page at the beginning of a book giving its title, the names of the author and illustrator is called the Title Page.</li> </ul>	

Table of Contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Lists the chapters of a book along with their page numbers.</li> </ul>	
Heading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ The heading divides the text into sections and explains what the sections will be about.</li> <li>✓ It is often in bold or capital letters.</li> </ul>	

Pictures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Pictures also help the reader understand an idea from the text that was unclear.</li> <li>✓ Photos and illustrations give information in a visual way.</li> </ul>	
Bold	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Bold prints are words that are <b>bolder</b> and much <b>darker</b> than the other printed words.</li> <li>✓</li> </ul>	<p>A Male killer whale is called a <b>bull</b>.</p> <p>Female killer whale is referred to as a <b>cow</b> and a baby killer whale is called a <b>calf</b>.</p>

Glossary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Tells the meaning of some of the words found in the story or text.</li> <li>✓ The words listed in the glossary are in alphabetical order.</li> </ul>
