Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
1. one syllable with <u>more than one vowel</u> or <u>more than one consonant at the end</u> . Example: <u>tall</u> - <u>short</u> - <u>cheap</u> - <u>light</u> - <u>old</u>	→ <u>add -er</u> <u>taller</u> - <u>shorter</u> - <u>cheaper</u> - <u>lighter</u> - <u>older</u>	→ <u>add -est</u> <u>tallest</u> - <u>shortest</u> - <u>cheapest</u> - <u>lightest</u> - <u>oldest</u>
2. one syllable <u>ending with e</u> . Example: <u>wide</u> - <u>fine</u> - <u>cute</u> - <u>nice</u>	→ <u>add -r</u> <u>wider</u> - <u>finer</u> - <u>cuter</u> - <u>nicer</u>	→ <u>add -st</u> <u>widest</u> - <u>finest</u> - <u>cutes</u> - <u>nices</u>
3. one syllable with <u>one vowel</u> and <u>one consonant at the end</u> . Example: <u>hot</u> - <u>big</u> - <u>fat</u> - <u>sad</u>	→ <u>double the last letter then add -er</u> <u>hotter</u> - <u>bigger</u> - <u>fatter</u> - <u>sadder</u>	→ double the last letter then add -est <u>hottest</u> - <u>biggest</u> - <u>fattest</u> - <u>saddest</u>
4. two syllables <u>ending with Y</u> . Example: <u>easy</u> - <u>happy</u> - <u>silly</u> - <u>lonely</u>	→ <u>change Y to i then add -er</u> <u>easier</u> - <u>happier</u> - <u>sillier</u> - <u>lonelier</u>	→ <u>change Y to i then add -est</u> <u>easiest</u> - <u>happiest</u> - <u>silliest</u> - <u>loneliest</u>
5. two syllables and more not ending with Y (<u>long adjective</u>). Example: <u>modern</u> - <u>beautiful</u> - <u>relax</u>	→ <u>use more before the adjective then than</u> <u>-more modern than</u> <u>-more beautiful than</u> <u>-more relax than</u>	→ <u>use the most before the adjective</u> <u>-the most modern</u> <u>-the most beautiful</u> <u>-the most relax</u>
6. <u>irregular adjectives</u> good bad far	→ better than worse than further than	→ the best the worst the furthest
7 <u>for equality</u> we use (as as) or (not as as)		e.g AL-Baha is as cold as Abha Riyadh is not as cold as Abha
