I'M FLYING.

WE USE "PRESENT
CONTINUOUS TENSE" TO TALK
ABOUT ACTIONS OCCURING
AT THE MOMENT



RULES: ADDING -ING

GENERAL RULE (most verbs)	ADD -ing	wear: wearing drink: drinking
VERBS ENDING IN -E	e add -ing	dance e : dancing have e : having
When a verb ends in Consonant + vowel + consonant	double the last consonant and add -ing	run: running swim: swimming sit: sitting

AFFIRMATIVE

I **am** sleeping now.
You **are** jumping now.
He **is** reading now.
She **is** drawing now.
It **is** running now.
We **are** dancing now.
You **are** writing now.
They **are** listening now.

Sujeto + am/is/are + verb
con -ing

NEGATIVE

I **am not** sleeping now.
You **aren't** jumping now.
He **isn't** reading now.
She **isn't** drawing now.
It **isn't** running now.
We **aren't** dancing now.
You **aren't** writing now.
They **aren't** listening now.

Sujeto + am
not/isn't/aren't + verb con

INTERROGATIVE

Am I sleeping?
Yes, I am/No, I am not.
Are you jumping?
Yes, I am/No, I am not.
Is he/she/it running?
Yes, he/she/it is/ No,
he/she/it isn't
Are we/they writing?
Yes, we/they are/
No, we/they aren't
