2. There are 12 pumpkins in our garden, and we purchased 12 more pumpkins from the farmer down the road. How many pumpkins do we have in total?
3. I need 14 pounds of pumpkin to make 12 pies. Each pumpkin weighs 2 pounds. How many pumpkins do I need to make the pies?
4. There are 14 bales of hay to feed the animals. We use 2 bales of hay each day. How many days will our 14 bales of hay last?
5. There are 18 squash of many different sizes in my garden. I cannot eat all of these! How many people can I give 3 squash each to?
6. I have picked 25 bushels of apples! I am going to can all these apples so that I can make pies and cook them throughout the winter. I need to have 12 jars for each bushel of apples. How many jars will I need?
7. There are too many peaches from the summer! I am going to freeze these peaches and store them away. I can freeze 6 peaches in one bag. If I have 218 peaches to freeze, how many bags do I need?
8. I am making walnut chocolate chip cookies. I must use these walnuts that are all over my yard! I need 2 pounds of walnuts for each batch of cookies. I have 8 pounds of walnuts. How many batches of cookies can I make?
