### **PLAGIARISM**

Plagiarism means presenting \_\_\_\_\_ ideas, work, or words \_\_\_\_\_ another person or persons without proper, clear, \_\_\_\_\_ unambiguous acknowledgement. If \_\_\_\_\_ acknowledgement \_\_\_\_\_ missing, you are, in effect, saying that what you \_\_\_\_\_ writing or presenting is your own—that it came from you—when \_\_\_\_\_ fact it is stolen from another person. This means that \_\_\_\_\_ student’s coursework (i.e. homework assignments, exams, etc.), thesis proposal, progress reports, final thesis, \_\_\_\_\_ even poster \_\_\_\_\_ slide presentations, must be that student’s own work. If other sources are used, they must be acknowledged.
