

Let Us Fix These Run-On Errors By Using Conjunctions



A run-on sentence is a sentence with two or more clauses (independent sentence containing a subject and predicate) squashed together improperly.

Fixing run-on sentence:

➤ **Separate using punctuation – period (.)**

Eg. I love to bake I would bake everyday if I was allowed by my mother.

I love to bake. I would bake everyday if I was allowed by my mother.

➤ **Separate using punctuation – semi-colon (;)**

Eg. I love to bake I would bake everyday if I was allowed by my mother.

1st clause: I love to bake

2nd clause: I would bake everyday if I was allowed by my mother.

I love to bake; I would bake everyday if I was allowed by my mother.

➤ **Separate using coordinating conjunction**

Eg. I love to bake I would bake everyday if I was allowed by my mother.

As I love to bake, I would bake everyday if allowed by my mother.

➤ **Reword the sentence by adding/removing/rearranging words.**

Eg. They went to the bus stop, they wanted to reach home before the lock down they missed it as all buses were cancelled.

1st clause: They went to the bus stop

2nd clause: they wanted to reach home before the lock down

3rd clause: they missed it as all buses were cancelled

They went to the bus stop because they wanted to reach home before the lock down. However, they missed it as all buses were cancelled.
