

Past perfect simple VS past perfect progressive

Past perfect	Form	Examples
	Had / hadn't + p.p	The train had left when we got to the station
Past perfect progressive	Had/hadn't + been + v (ing)	He had been living in London for 15 years when he moved to Glasgow

- 6/ I had been [**wait** – **waited** – **waitng** – **waits**] for him since four-thirty
