Ramon Luis Ayala Rodriguez was born in Puerto Rico in 1977. He played baseball when he was young, and he played a lot of baseball games with his friends. He wanted to be a professional baseball player. But he had a problem with his leg, so he didn't play very well. He knew he wasn't a great athlete, but he liked music, too, and that's where he put his energy. As a teenager, he learned a lot about rap music from rap musicians in his country, Puerto Rico. Ramon worked with other Puerto Rican musicians to create a new kind of music-reggaeton. They all saw Ramon's talent.

In 1995, he made his first album, *No Mercy*, using the name Daddy Yankee. People liked his music, and he made two more albums. But it was Daddy Yankee's fourth album, El Cangry.com in 2002 that made him and reggaeton music famous internationally.


