

transport	Move people and things from one place to another.
safety	Keep away from danger/harm.
rules	Something that tells you what you must/must not do.
pedals	Parts you push with your feet on a bike.
brakes	Part of a vehicle that slows it down.
vehicle	A machine like a car/bus that carries people/things from place to place.
passenger	A person who travels in a vehicle but is not the driver.
seatbelt	A belt fixed to a seat in a vehicle that keeps you safe when moving.
helmet	A hard hat to keep your head safe.
pavement	side of the road where people walk

Sharif woke up. He was late and needed to get to school. He quickly got on his bike. When he got near to school he saw a small red car on the left.



a) He thought, "I can get past the car before it crosses in front." He pedalled very quickly but the car was faster.

The car hit him.



b) He thought, "I need to slow down. He saw a 'Stop' sign and slowed down to stop. The small red car crossed in front and then he pedalled to school.

The car went past.
