

Alain Robert from France has always loved climbing. When he was twelve years old, he arrived home without his keys and his parents weren't at home- so he climbed up the side of the building and went in through the window. They lived on the eighth floor of an apartment building! As a young man, he learned rock climbing in the French Alps. But today, he is famous as an "urban climber". He has climbed buildings all over the world- some of them have been the world's tallest. In March 2011, Alain climbed the world's tallest building (the 828-meter-high Burj Khalifa, Dubai) in only six hours!

Alain has also climbed many buildings without permission. When he climbed the Petronas Twin Towers in Kuala Lumpur, a group of police officers were waiting for him. They met him at the top when he finished his climb, and then arrested him. However, Alain has never broken anything on the buildings he has climbed. He has always been very careful not to damage them. Some of Alain's climbs have been legal, and sometimes people pay him for climbing, too. In 2005, he had a tattoo of the name of a company on his back. The company paid him to climb the Cheung Kong Center in Hong Kong as an advertisement for them. After the climb, he washed the tattoo off- it was only temporary.

Alain continues to climb the world's tallest buildings, and he has now written a book about his experiences. But he has never tried skydiving or paragliding. Alain suffers from vertigo- he is scared of heights. He has fallen badly on a few occasions, but he has never stopped climbing.
