

The human brain has billions of small cells known as neurons. These neurons send and received information throughout the body.

The human brain is divided into these three main parts:

1. - Cerebrum: It is the larger part of the brain. This part of the brain helps us in moving around, thinking, speaking and learning.

2. - Cerebellum: This part of the brain is located just under the cerebrum. This part of the brain helps you sit straight and maintain your balance while you walk and run. It helps in muscle movements across the body.

3.- Brain stem: This thin and small part of the brain connects both the cerebellum and the cerebrum to the spinal cord present in your back. It helps in many important functions like coughing, sneezing, digestion, and maintaining our body temperature and heartbeat.
