Affirmative form (trdilna oblika)

I You We They	play	volleyball. football. basketball. the piano. the drums.
He She It	plays	

Negative form (nikalna oblika)

I You We They	don't (do not)	play	volleyball. football. basketball. the piano. the drums.
He She It	doesn't (does not)		

Question form (vprašalna oblika)

Do	I You We They	play	volleyball? football? basketball? the piano? the drums?
Does	He She It		

Wh-questions

When Where How	do	I you we they	play	volleyball? football? basketball? the piano? the drums?

Pazil

- V trdilni obliki v 3. osebi ednine (he, she, it) glagolu dodamo črko „s“. **Pri glagolih, ki se končajo na sh, ch, x, s in o** pa dodamo črki „es“.
- V vprašalni in nikalni obliki glagol **NIMA** končnic. „S“ se že skriva v besedah **does** (do + es) in **doesn't** (do + es + not).
- Kadar se glagol konča na „y“ pred njim pa stoji soglasnik, se „y“ spremeni v „ies“.

Uporaba:

- Za izražanje splošnih resnic, dejstev**
*One and one is two. The grass is green. The ball is round.
- Za izražanje navad in običajev**
* I drink coffee in the morning. I go to school by bus.
- Za opisovanje vsakdanjika, kaj pogosto / ponavadi počnemo**
(Opis dneva, meseca, leta itd.)
