Grammar Rules: Compounds

A **compound subject** has two subjects joined by **and** or **or**.

Jaden and Suhail march in the parade every year.

The subject and verb of a sentence must agree.

- If you see **and**, use a plural verb.
- If you see **or**, look at the last simple subject.
- If it is **singular**, then use a **singular verb**.
- If it is **plural**, then use a **plural verb**.

Rodha and Reem ride on the float.
Hamad or the clown blows the horn.
The dog or cats jump through the hoop.
