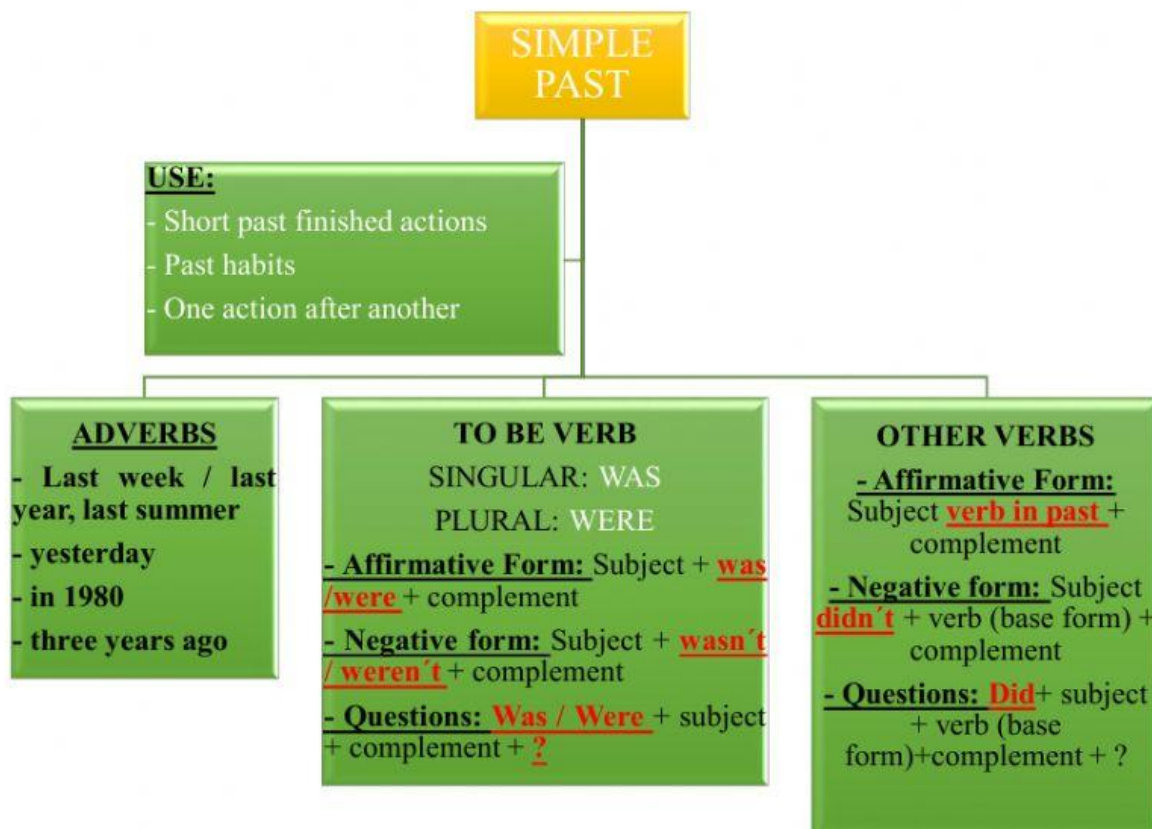

REGULAR VERBS		- To write the past simple of a regular verb we add “-ed” to the base form. ➤ Work Work<u>ed</u> ➤ Play Play<u>ed</u> ➤ Paint Paint<u>ed</u>	
SPELLING RULES	- To avoid spelling mistakes we must remember three rules: ➤ After consonant+vowel+consonant we double the last consonant when the syllable is stressed. ✓ Stop Stop<u>ped</u> ✓ Clap Clap<u>ped</u>	- When the verb ends in -e, we drop the -e and add the suffix. ➤ Move Mov<u>ed</u> ➤ Rule Rul<u>ed</u> ➤ Live Liv<u>ed</u>	- When the verb ends in consonant+y we drop the “y” and write “i+ed”. ➤ Cry Cried ➤ Try Tried
