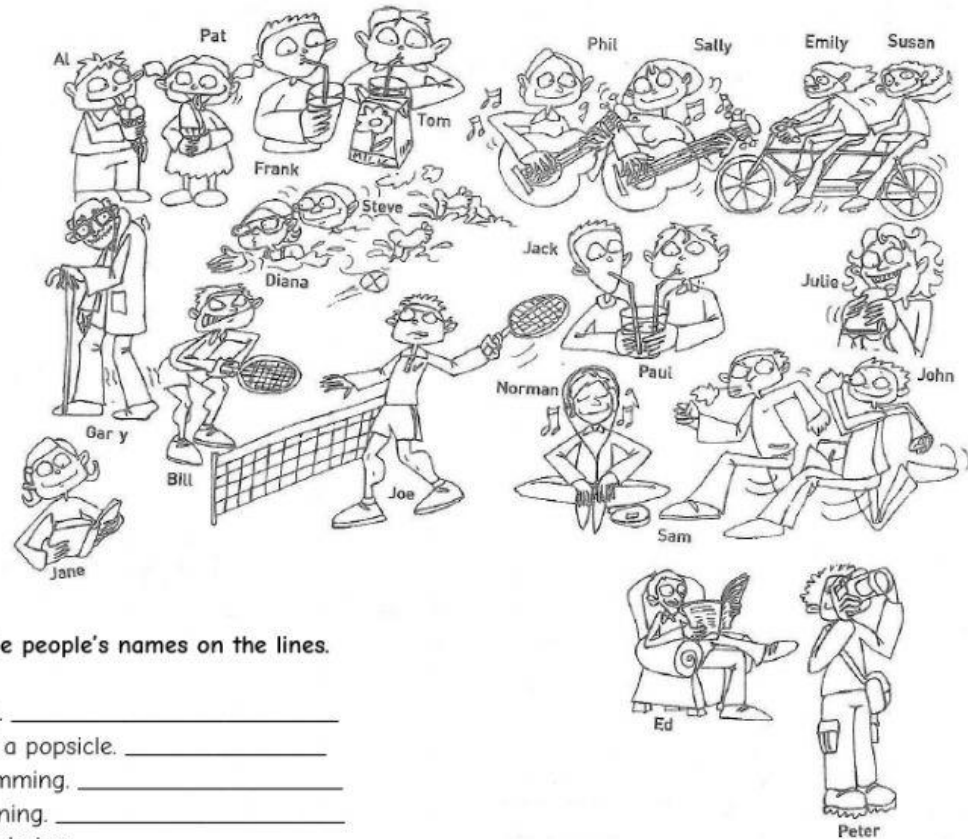


PRESENT CONTINUOUS
