eat bread?  
Does he/she/it eat bread?

THE VERB DOESN'T CHANGE IN  
3RD PERSON SINGULAR!

Does she ~~eat~~ bread?  
Does she eat bread? ✓

Yes, I do.  
No, I don't.  
Yes, she does.  
No, she doesn't.
