Topic: Kinds of Sentences -

Imperative and Exclamatory Sentences

**Remember:** All sentences begin with a capital letter and ends with a punctuation mark.

#### A. Imperative Sentence

An **imperative sentence** gives a command, provides instruction or offers an advice. Imperative sentences end with a period (•).

For example:

1. Brush your teeth twice a day.
2. Clean your room .

#### B. Exclamatory Sentence

An **exclamatory sentence** shows strong feeling or surprise.

Exclamatory Sentences end with an exclamation mark (!).

For example:

1. Hooray! We won the game!
2. Wow, he performed very well!
