

the PRESENT CONTINUOUS

USE: We use the Present Continuous to express: something happening now / something temporary / something changing / fixed plans for the immediate future

FORM: The Present Continuous is like an airplane that needs

two wings to fly

"to be" as an auxiliary verb

the main verb with -ing



'TO BE' IN THE PRESENT:

I am / I'm
you are / you're
he is / he's
she is / she's
it is / it's
we are / we're
you are / you're
they are / they're

SPELLING RULES:

- * most verbs: + -ing
- * verbs ending in -e: e + -ing
- * verbs ending in -le: le + y + -ing
- * verbs ending in single, **stressed** vowel and single consonant (except for 'x'): consonant x2 + -ing
- * verbs ending in single vowel + l: l x2 + -ing (in British English only)

Good! Now let's see how to make questions and negative sentences.

For questions, **am/is/are** goes in the beginning of the sentence. Then we say **[WHO is doing what the verb says]**, then the verb + **ing**. And we don't forget the **"?"** at the end!

I am working.

The girl next to me is listening to music.

Jenny and Tim are sleeping.

Am I working?

Is the girl next to me listening to music?

Are Jenny and Tim sleeping?

For negative sentences, we add "not" after am/is/are. We can also have short forms: I'm not, you aren't, he isn't, she isn't, it isn't, we aren't, you aren't, they aren't.

I am working. I am not working. She is listening to music. She is not listening to music.

I'm not working. I'm not working. She is listening to music. She isn't listening to music.

They are sleeping. They are not sleeping.

They aren't sleeping.

Short answers: We can give short answers by writing Yes, + [you/he/she/it/we/you/they + am/is/are or No, + I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they + am not/are not/is not/are not (OR their short forms).

Are you working? Yes, I am. Is she listening to music? Yes, she is. Are they sleeping? Yes, they are.

Are you working? No, I am not. Is she listening to music? No, she is not. Are they sleeping? No, they are not.

OR, No, I'm not.

OR, No, she isn't.

OR, No, they aren't.

Alright so far? Great! Let's practise everything!
