

PARTS OF THE DICTIONARY

Draw a line from the word on the left to match the correct explanation of its use.

Entry word

This explains the meaning of the entry word. If there is more than one meaning, the definition is divided by numbers. Also, an example sentence is often used to make the meaning more clear.

Pronunciation

Shows the origin of the entry word.

Definition

This abbreviation tells you what part of speech the defined word is.

Guide words

This is the word entered in the dictionary. The (.) separates the syllables. The 1 notes there are more than one definition entry.

Part of speech

Shows how the entry word is written in plural form

Plural form

This is separated into syllables and tells you how to pronounce the entry word. The ´ tells you which syllable is stressed.

Origin

This tells you the first and last words defined on each page.
