<u>Past simple</u>	
Form	S. V+ ed / 2 nd form of irregular verb O. Ex. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It was dark last night.• We went for shopping yesterday.• She played with her sister.
Question	Did you go for shopping? What did they do?
Key words	Ago , yesterday , in 1998 , last
Negative	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I <u>didn't</u> play football.• They <u>didn't</u> go for shopping.

affirmative	I , he , she + was + v(ing) We , you, they+ v (ing)	He was working You were working
Negative	Wasn't/ weren't + v (ing)	He wasn't working You weren't working
Question	Was/ were + S + v (ing)	Was he working ? Was you working ?
