WATER

Without water, life could not exist. Because water is essential to all life, we must manage it intelligently and carefully. We think there is plenty of it – oceans, lakes, rivers, and streams. It may even seem as though we have more water than we need. Unfortunately, the reality is not the case.

Water is essential to people in more ways than you might think. We need water for cooking, bathing, transportation and recreation. We eat aquatic plants and animals. We use water to irrigate our crops, and to manufacture products.

Most of the water on Earth (97 percent) is salt water stored in oceans. Only about three percent of the Earth's water is fresh water, and most of that is locked up in ice caps and glaciers. There will never be more water on Earth than there is now. The same water is simply recycled over and over again. Just think –the water we are using now is the very same water the dinosaurs used to drink millions of years ago.

There is no need to keep the water running while brushing your teeth. Just wet your brush and fill a glass for mouth rinsing.

This may save ten or more gallons of water per day. Be sure at least 3 gallons of water remain in the tank so it will flush properly.

It uses less water than the shortest shower.

A small drip from a worn faucet washer can waste 20 gallons of water per day.

This simple practice can save as much as 150 gallons when washing a car.

A four - minute shower uses approximately 20 to 40 gallons of water.

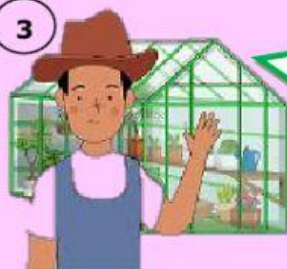
