Children need to make healthy decisions about whether to use these technologies in ways that will help them grow and develop into healthy, productive citizens

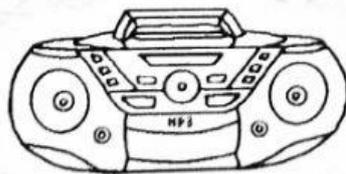
Guidelines for Safe Use of Technology:

- Use the internet for constructive purposes instead of surfing the net
- Exercise precaution when viewing various technology devices, e.g. imitating what athletes and superstars in magazines and on TV do. These actions can result in unhealthy behaviours and can harm the body.

Compare technology used today in the past.



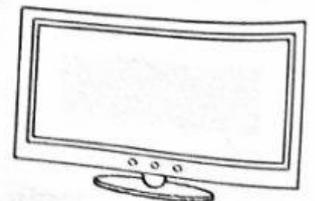
