Grammar: Past tense regular verbs

Affirmative

Regular verbs:

Add – **ed** Example: Walk – Walk**ed** Clean – Clean**ed** Work - work**ed**

- Verbs ending in a **vowel** and **Y**

Add – **ed** Example: Stay – Stay**ed** Play – Play**ed**

- Verbs ending in: **e**

Add -ed Example: Die - Died Close - Closed Live - Lived

• Verbs ending in **Consonant + Y**

Change the "Y" to **i** and then add **-ed** Example:

Study – Studied

Marry – Married

Cry – Cried

- Verbs ending in One vowel + one consonant but not ending in W or Y

Double the consonant + **ed** example: Commit = committed Wrap = wrap**ped**
