## Pronunciation regular verbs in past.

A/ Record the sentence. Use your cellphone mic. Be careful with the VERB IN PAST.

REMEMBER THE PRONUNCIATION:

### Pronunciation of ED

/ɪd/	/t/	/d/
T wanted D needed	P helped K looked F sniffed GH laughed SH washed CH watched SS kissed C danced X fixed	L called N cleaned R offered G damaged V loved S used Z amazed B rubbed M claimed
<b>* Voiced Sound</b> = uses the vocal cords and they produce a vibration or humming sound in the throat. <i>(Touch your throat to feel it)</i>	<b>VOICELESS</b>	<b>VOICED *</b>

Words that end in a vowel sound use the /d/ pronunciation for ED.  
e.g. -- followed -- enjoyed -- played -- tried -- continued

The pronunciation of words ending in ED depends on the final consonant sound. There are three ways to pronounce ED at the end of a word in English:  
/ɪd/ /t/ /d/
