Positive (+)	Negative (-)
I/ he/ she/ it was	I/ he/ she/ it wasn't (was not)
We/ you/ they were	We/ you/ they weren't (were not)

Was I/ he/ she/ it?	Yes, I/ he/ she/ it was No, I/ he/ she/ it wasn't
Were We/ you/ they?	Yes, I/ he/ she/ it were No, I/ he/ she/ it weren't

PAST SIMPLE	
Positive (+)	Negative (-)
Verb + ed	Didn't + verb
I/ you/ he/ she/ it/ we/ they worked	I/ you/ he/ she/ it/ we/ they didn't (did not) work
