# QUESTION TAGS



Question tags are short questions at the end of statements. They are used in speech when we want to confirm that something is true or not, or to encourage a reply from the person we are speaking to.

(Question tags (upitni privesci) se koriste kako bismo pitali nekoga da li se slaže sa nečim. Prevode se sa "nije li", "zar ne" ... )

Question tags are formed with the auxiliary or modal verb from the statement and the appropriate subject pronoun. (Question tag se gradi pomoću pomoćnih ili modalnih glagola i odgovarajuće lične zamenice.)



A positive statement is followed by a negative question tag. A negative statement is followed by a positive question tag.

(Akoje rečenica potvrdna, Question tag mora da bude odričan, i obrnuto- ako je rečenica odrična, Question tag je potvrdan.)

| Past Continuous Tense<br>(was/ were)      | John was singing,             | wasn't he?                        | John wasn't singing,             | was he?                     |
| Present Perfect Tense<br>(have/has)       | You have bought this book,    | haven't you?                      | You haven't bought this book,    | have you?                   |
| Future Simple Tense<br>(will)             | Grandma will make a cake,     | won't she?<br>(won't=will<br>not) | Grandma won't make a cake,       | will she?                   |

That is your book over there, isn't it?
(this/ that- odgovarajuća zamenica je IT)

## Everything is done, isn't it?

Ako je subjekat u glavnoj rečenici neka od sledećih neodređenih zamenica (something, anything, everything, nothing), koristimo IT kao odgovarajuću ličnu zamenicu u Question tag-u. Anyone can solve this maths problem, can't THEY? Nobody is perfect, are they?

Ako je subjekat u glavnoj rečenici neka neodređena zamenica (anyone, anybody, no one, nobody, none, neither, everyone, somebody, someone, everybody...), koristimo THEY kao odgovarajuću ličnu zamenicu u Question tag-u.

Open the window, will you?
Close the door, will you?
Don't open the window, won't you?
