➤ Synonyms

Sometimes **synonyms** (words with similar meanings) are used in or near the sentence with the unknown word. A **parentheses after the unknown word** may offer the meaning of the word. The conjunction **or** may also be followed by another meaning of the word.

Example: I **hate** or *detest* eating green beans.
