(1) \_\_\_\_\_ in the mountainous border Duy Xuyen District of Quang Nam Province, My Son Sanctuary is Viet Nam's most important site of the **ancient** kingdom of Champa.

Đoạn 2.

My Son is a **complex** of Hindu (2) \_\_\_\_\_ that were **constructed** by the Champa kingdom, which **ruled** the Central and Southern part of Vietnam, from the 3rd century (3) \_\_\_\_\_. 1832. The first temples of My Son were constructed with wood during the 4th century. After they were (4) \_\_\_\_\_ by fire, the kings of the Champa kingdom decided to build the next structures with red bricks. The Cham people used the temples as a (5) \_\_\_\_\_ place, and also buried some of their kings there.
