### Remember the affirmative forms:

#### AFFIRMATIVE

I <b>go</b> to school every day
You <b>go</b> to school every day
He <b>goes</b> to school every day
She <b>goes</b> to school every day
It <b>goes</b> to school every day
We <b>go</b> to school every day
They <b>go</b> to school every day

With **HE**, **SHE** and **IT** we add **S**  
or **ES** to the verb.

### S or ES?:

- **ES**: for verbs ending in O – CH – SH – SS – ZZ – X
- **IE + S**: for verbs ending in Y after a consonant.  
Example:  
STUDY = STUDIES

#### NEGATIVE

I <b>don't go</b> to school every day
You <b>don't go</b> to school every day
He <b>doesn't go</b> to school every day
She <b>doesn't go</b> to school every day
It <b>doesn't go</b> to school every day
We <b>don't go</b> to school every day
They <b>don't go</b> to school every day

**Remember the interrogative forms:**

INTERROGATIVE
Do I go to school every day? Yes, I <b>do</b> //No, I <b>don't</b>
Do you go to school every day? Yes, I <b>do</b> //No, I <b>don't</b>
Does he go to school every day? Yes, he <b>does</b> //No, he <b>doesn't</b>
Does she go to school every day? Yes, she <b>does</b> //No, she <b>doesn't</b>
Does it go to school every day? Yes, it <b>does</b> //No, it <b>doesn't</b>
Do we go to school every day? Yes, we <b>do</b> //No, we <b>don't</b>
Do they go to school every day? Yes, they <b>do</b> //No, they <b>don't</b>
