- 1) It is a genre of popular music that is meant to be soothing and relaxing to the listener.
- 2) Generally referred as EDM, this form of music is produced by DJs who add dozens of tones to a piece to create unique music. You can hear them in clubs or even live. In the early twenties, this music genre was known in the form of Jamaican dub music.
- 3) It is also known as rap music. The music is accompanied by an instrumental track, usually referred to as “beat”, performed by a DJ, created by a producer, or one or more instrumentalists. This music genre began in The Bronx, New York.
- 4) It refers to most orchestral styles between 1750 and 1820. It came as a reaction to the rules and restrictions prevalent in baroque music.
- 5) It is a sub-genre of rock music that developed in the late 1960s in the United Kingdom and the United States. In this genre people began to exploit the characteristics of the electric guitar to create louder sounds. It is characterized by aggressive rhythm, often involving those themes as drug abuse, death, or political issues.
- 6) This is another popular genre of American music which originated in the 1920s, this music genre has its roots from American folk and western music. It is formed using simple forms of instruments from electric and steel guitars to drums and mandolin. Some very popular singers of this genre include Shania Twain, Johnny Cash, Taylor Swift and Kenny Rogers.
