DESERT

Deserts (0) are the driest (1) _____ on Earth, which can make it difficult for plants and animals to survive. While it can rain, in a desert, they get less than ten inches of precipitation per year. With such (2) _____ land, temperature can get over 100 degrees F.

Living things have learnt to adapt to the dry habitat of a desert. Deserts are full of (3) _____ and animals that don't need much water to live. Some plants can wait years for rain. A cactus can hold water in (4) _____ stem, so it does not need rain very often. Other plants have very long roots that can reach to water store deep underground. (5) _____ animals that live in desert habitats are nocturnal, only coming out when the hot (6) _____ has gone down. Other animals hide underground or among large rocks to stay in the shade. Animals can get (7) _____ from eating seeds, or from eating other animals.
