Remember!

WHO

It is used to refer to people
Example: The man who works at the
Theater is very kind.

WHICH

It refers to animals and objects
Example: Tina has a bunch of flowers
which his fan bought.

WHOSE

It is used to refer to possession
Example: Have you seen the girl whose
favorite singer died last week?

THAT

It is used to refer to people, animals,
It can replace WHO or WHICH
Example: The blue jacket that she is
putting on belongs to her friend.

WHERE

It used to refer to places
The arena where they performed was
excellent

WHEN

It is used to refer to time
That was the day when Ed Sheeran
started the tour.
