Irregular Plurals



There are some nouns that are irregular in the plural form.

That means that you cannot just add -s, -es, or -ies to make them plural.

These nouns can be like your opposing team's top secret play-book. You have to figure them out!

Example: Man- Men
Woman- Women

Some Nouns Don't Change

Some nouns are the same in their singular and plural form. You do not add -s or change the form of these nouns.

Example: Deer- Deer
Sheep- Sheep



Some Nouns change Endings

Some nouns change endings in the plural form.

Let's take a closer look!

If a noun ends in -f or -fe, drop the -f or -fe and add -ves

wife - wives
leaf - leaves
life - lives
knife - knives



If a noun ends in a consonant and -o, add -es

tomato - tomatoes
